

## Photography Competition – Rules and Eligibility

The NZ Young Farmers Photography Competition has been designed to help create a digital record of our people, animals and the beautiful landscape we live in. Entrants don't have to be professional photographers, just passionate about showing the rest of the world who we are.

**The competition has Three categories:**

### **1. Huntaway or Heading dog**

A photo of a Huntaway or Heading dog.

### **2. Farm Landscapes**

Show off your farm's unique beauty.

### **3. You and your working dogs**

Capture a photo of you and your working dog or dogs.

**Overall Winner:**

### **Photo of the year**

The top photo across all three categories.

Be creative and think outside the box when addressing the themes. Photographs can be colour or black-and-white, realistic or abstract. This is an opportunity to express yourself through your photography.

### **Prizes**

RRP \$400 worth of Royal Canin working dog food per category.

RRP \$800 worth of Royal Canin working dog food for Photo of the Year.

### **Photo submission period**

1 October 2018 – 10 December 2019

### **Judging**

Photos will be judged by a panel and the winners will be announced at the new-look NZ Young Farmers Conference Week and on the NZYF website.

### **Awards ceremony**

The winners will be announced at the New Holland National Awards in February 2019.

### **Entry criteria**



Submission of photos in the NZYF Photography Competition is deemed acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

Entrants must be current TeenAg members (fully paid individual membership) and NZYF members throughout submission period. NZYF employees and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter.

1. Each entrant must submit a signed entry form.
2. Photos must be taken by the entrant.
3. It is entrant's responsibility to obtain appropriate written permission from people or owners of property that are identifiable in their photographs.
4. Entries are required to be submitted via email [jake.lonergan@youngfarmers.co.nz](mailto:jake.lonergan@youngfarmers.co.nz), or on a USB to PO Box 23141, Templeton 8445. If entry is sent via USB please email Jake to advise an entry will be received.
5. Each Photo **must** be labelled using the following format: "Name, Club, (e.g. Bob Jones, Waitane,).
6. **Photo size must be a minimum of 1MB and in jpeg format – We do not accept any other format**
7. The photograph, in its entirety, must be a single work of original material taken by the contest entrant. By entering the contest, the entrant represents, acknowledges, and warrants that the submitted photograph is an original work created solely by the entrant, that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the photograph.
8. Entrants can enter up to three photos per categories.
9. Upon signing the entry form, the entrant consents to their photographs being used by NZYF/Royal Canin for promotional purposes which includes, but is not limited to, publication on websites and social media.
10. The entrant fully indemnifies NZYF against any claims arising from the display or use of any entry by NZYF.
11. There is no entry fee is required for this competition.
12. At all times, the judge's decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
13. The prizes are to be accepted as awarded and no other product or cash in lieu of the prize shall be negotiated for.
