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We call upon all NZYF members who are passionate photographers to create a digital record of our people, our animals and the beautiful landscape that we live in to show the rest of the world who we are.

### Photography Competition Categories

1. People/Animals
2. NZYF Activities
3. Landscape/Scenic
4. Mobile Images
5. People's Choice Award – you can nominate only ONE of your entries for this category.

### Photo Submission Period

1 February 2018 – 1 June 2018

### Judging

Photos will be judged by a guest photographer and winners will be showcased at the National Competition Finals and on the New Zealand Young Farmers website.

### Awards Ceremony

The winners will be announced at the NZYF National Awards Dinner in July 2018.

### Entry Rules

Submission of photos in the Photography Competition is deemed acceptance of the following terms and conditions:

1. Entrants must be current TeenAg members (fully paid individual membership) and NZYF members throughout submission period. NZYF employees and their immediate family members are ineligible to enter.
2. Each entrant must submit a signed entry form.
3. Photos must be taken by the entrant.
4. It is entrant's responsibility to obtain appropriate written permission from people or owners of property that are identifiable in their photographs.
5. Entries are required to be submitted via email or dropbox to david.highsted@youngfarmers.co.nz or on a USB to PO Box 23141, Templeton 8445. If entry is sent via USB please email David to advise an entry will be received.
6. Each Photo **must** be labelled using the following format: "Name, Club, Category" (e.g. Bob Jones, Waitane, Landscape/Scenic 1).
7. **Photo size must be a minimum of 1MB and in jpeg format – We do not accept any other format**
8. Photos must not be retouched in anyway.
9. Entrants can enter up to 3 photos in each category (excluding the People's Choice Award Category).
10. Entrants can choose their favourite photo to be entered into the People's Choice Award. Voting for the People's Choice Award will take place on the NZYF Facebook page by its members from 14 May 2018 until 5pm NZST 1 June 2018.
11. Entrants may share their photo entered into the People's Choice Award on Facebook and solicit votes from their friends and family in good faith. Soliciting votes from online "vote for me" websites

is not allowed and will be deemed invalid. In the event of any sort of large scale voting, NZYF will investigate to make sure there has been no foul play. NZYF reserves the right to discount any votes deemed invalid or to disqualify the entrant all together.

12. Upon signing the entry form, the entrant consents to their photographs being used by NZYF for promotional purposes which includes, but is not limited to, publication on websites and social media.
13. The entrant fully indemnifies NZYF against any claims arising from the display or use of any entry by NZYF.
14. There is no entry fee is required for this competition.
15. At all times, the judge’s decision is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
16. The prizes are to be accepted as awarded and no other product or cash in lieu of the prize shall be negotiated for.
