What does this role involve?

- *Liaise with the Regional H&S Officer and Field Officer, if unsure on anything*
- *Report on H&S matters at each meeting*
- *Carry out a H&S induction at meetings (fire exits, bathrooms etc)*
- *Reporting any injuries/near misses to NZYF national office*
- *Preferably hold a first aid certificate*
- *Actively engage with any community activities that benefit the members (Farmstrong, Good Yarns, Rural Support Trust)*

Responsibilities:

- *Have a good understanding of Young Farmers H&S paperwork (can learn on the job)*
- *Be a positive face and drive forward the new procedures*
- *Target mental health not just the physical side of H&S*
- *Back up the events team – aim to have no injuries at events*

- *Lead your region in H&S*

- *Ensuring that your regional exec monitor that clubs in your region complete H&S paperwork for all events and stored appropriately (any issues to be directed to national office).*
- *Liaise with the Field Officer and NZYF H&S Chair, if unsure on anything*
- *Report on H&S matters at regional meetings*
- *Carry out a H&S induction at meetings (fire exits, bathrooms etc)*
- *Reporting any injuries/near misses to NZYF national office*
- *Preferably hold a first aid certificate*
- *Work alongside the Club Health and Safety Officers to ensure they are doing their job*
- *Actively engage with any community activities that benefit the members (Farmstrong, Good Yarns, Rural Support Trust)*
- *Attend 1-2 H&S workshops annually with NZ Young Farmers H&S Chair*
- *Help organise H&S training for your region*

- *Be a positive face and drive forward the new procedures across your region*
- *Target mental health not just the physical side of H&S*
- *Back up the events team – aim to have no injuries, but sound reporting of near misses*
- *Work with NZYF H&S Chair to ensure all events complete H&S across the whole organisation*
