

Regional Chairperson

Responsibilities:

- Lead Regional Executive to function effectively as a Region.
- Take ownership for developing and implementing Regional Strategic plan in consultation with Regional Executive.
- Responsibility for following up and understanding the reasons for membership trends in the region.
- Be available and approachable by Chairpersons and members of all Clubs, and ensuring the Regional Executive has regular interaction with all clubs.
- Work with Regional Development Officer to evaluate the Clubs in your Region, and provide growth assistance opportunities to all clubs in the region.
- Represent the Region at all National Committee meetings held through the year, and other National events.
- Participate fully in planning and implementing policy for NZ Young Farmers.
- Support and assist NZ Young Farmers staff as required with information and in any other way that may be beneficial to the NZ Young Farmers organisation.
- Liaise regularly with the appointed board member.

Regional vice Chairs

Responsibilities:

- Vice Chairs must be ready at all times to step into the Chairperson's roles.
- Assist the Regional Chair with developing and implementing Regional Strategic plan in consultation with Regional Executive.
- Regular and open interaction with clubs in the Region.
- Be available and approachable by Chairpersons and members of all Clubs.

District Development Team

Responsibilities:

- The point of contact between the region and our individual members, Clubs and Districts.
- Be the 'eyes and ears on the ground'
- Communicate to and from region any news, initiatives, issues
- Have a 'ground up' rather than top-down approach

Finance Team

Responsibilities:

- Oversee the financial wellbeing of the Region
- Create and manage the budget
- Make financial decisions on behalf of the Region
- Seek sponsorship and funding
- Ensure a financially sustainable Region

Communications Team

Responsibilities:

- Communicate Regional News, Updates, Events and Information to all members in Region
- Gather information (upcoming events, happenings etc) from members and Clubs within Region to share with others
- Keep regular communication via social media (Facebook and twitter) and manage appropriate content on these pages. Send out monthly 'Newsletter emails
- Write and review articles for public distribution

Events Team

Responsibilities

- Co-ordinate Regional Events
- Lead a team of Regional members for each event
- Create and distribute Regional Events Calendar
- Communicate Club events on in the Region to members
- Help promote events that are open to the wider public

Contest Organiser

Responsibilities:

- Co-ordinate District and Regional Finals in the Region
- Be the point of contact between NZYF Contest committee and Region Contest Committee
- Communicate contest information to and from the Region
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Health and Safety Officer

Responsibilities

- Be aware of H&S issues within the organizational setting
- Report to regional meetings on H&S matters
- Work within the region exec to ensure H&S regulations are met where necessary
- Compile and create a H&S Register where necessary

Industry Delegates

Federated Farmers Delegate

Responsibilities

- Attend Federated Farmers meetings and represent the Region
- Be the point of contact between Federated Farmers Young Farmers
- Communicate initiatives to and from the Region
- Co-ordinate Region sponsorship

TB Free Delegate

Responsibilities

- Attend TB Free meetings and represent the Region
- Be the point of contact between TB Free and Young Farmers
- Communicate initiatives to and from the Region
- Co-ordinate Region sponsorship
